Estimated number of beneficiaries of Emergency Unemployment Compensation (EUC), suspension of Federal income tax on up to \$2400 of Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits, and Federal Additional Compensation (FAC), which increased all UI weekly benefits by \$25, due to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act
